From the [NC Medicaid EHR Incentive Program](#):

“NC-MIPS is now accepting AIU and Modified MU attestations for Program Year 2015. Please carefully review your attestation and documentation for accuracy and completeness. If we are unable to validate your attestation with the information submitted by April 30, 2016, you will be denied for Program Year 2015.”

- Is your volume information correct?
- Is payee information correct?
- Does your EHR certification number need to be updated? If so, this can take a few days to update in the CMS EHR Incentive Registration portal and will delay your ability to attest with NC Medicaid.
- Are all usernames and passwords correct?

Quality Use and Resource (QRUR) reports are made available by CMS to practitioners to provide feedback on quality of care and resource utilization for their Medicare fee-for-service patients.
